

HELP SAVE YOUR COMMUNITY PUB

An Antwerp Arms Association Community Consultation



Dear Neighbours,

Firstly, due to Covid, the **Antwerp Arms** sustained big losses this year and our local community pub could be facing threat of closure. But we are trying to battle on and have developed a valuable role for the Antwerp running community support projects. With teams of our local AAA volunteers, one of our Antwerp community projects is now delivering **200 free** hot meals and food bags in Tottenham and Haringey every Thursday.

These activities have altered our original business model for the Antwerp and we now intend that when the Annie re-opens, as well as being our local community pub, evenings and weekends - it will also become a daytime community hub/Café. We are developing a programme of daytime AAA community activities and need more local people involved in the AAA to help us run them. Also, just as soon as we can, we will be restarting our quarterly local community meetings. Please let us know if you would like to help - and if there are any activities that you would like the pub to offer.

Secondly, as we come out of lockdown, the Government is ruling that initially, hospitality can be only be operated in **outdoor settings**. The Antwerp has too small a rear garden for this purpose, so it would not be viable for us to open at all. To be able to open when permitted in April, we need to re-establish some summertime table service opposite the pub, and so we are applying to **LB Haringey** for a 6 month licence to trial this from 12 April until October. It will then be reviewed for next year.

If this trial is permitted, we will ensure that no tables face onto any houses in Church Road. We will keep the area clean and tidy - and we will move the tables and safely secure them whenever the pub is closed. We will advise pub customers to keep any noise to a minimum. Also security will be provided, if by some chance, there are any matches or event days at the Spurs stadium. We are also lobbying LBH to return some traffic calming measures to the road outside the pub and would greatly appreciate your support in this. **Please reply to the questions on the reverse of this letter.**
